

National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Requirements for Permit Projects Within State Highway Right-of-Way

The Contractor shall obtain and comply with the *National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Requirements for Oahu District Permit Projects*. This is available at the Oahu District office at 727 Kakoi Street (Ph. 831-6793). Due to potential cost impacts, the Contractor needs to be aware of these requirements.

The Contractor shall complete and submit a *Contractor's Certification of NPDES Compliance*, including completion of the *Best Management Practice (BMP) Checklist* and submittal of a written BMP plan and drawings, prior to issuance of the Permit to Perform Work Upon State Highways. Due to potential time impacts on reviewing BMPs, the Contractor needs to allow enough time for the approval process.

The Contractor shall follow the guidelines in the Highways Division's "Construction Best Management Practices Field Manual" in developing, installing and maintaining the Best Management Practices (BMPs) for the project.

The Contractor shall follow the guidelines in the City and County of Honolulu's "Rules for Soil Erosion Standards and Guidelines" for the project.
